Any deduction from value approved will affect the tax bills due next year. The amount of the deduction equals a percentage of the reduction in value caused by the damage or destruction. That percentage is determined by the calendar quarter in which the damage occurred. The filing deadline and percentage deduction allowed for each calendar quarter are shown below.
