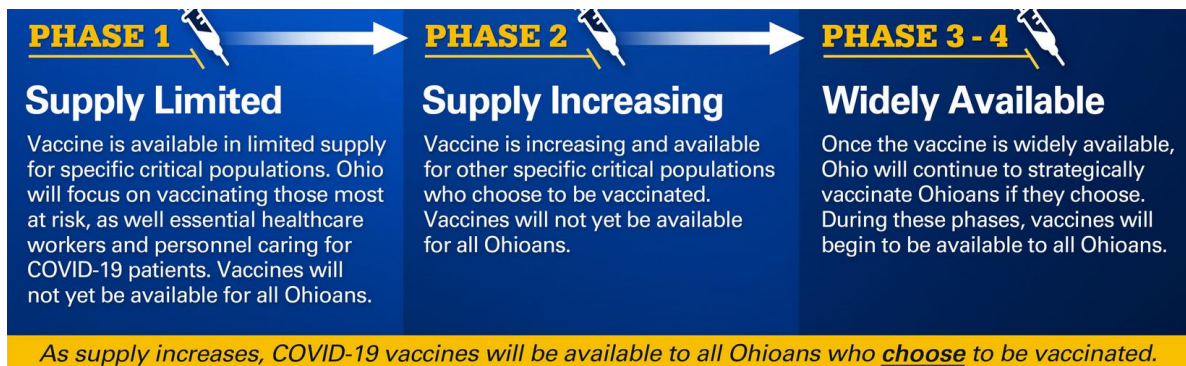

- **Started - Cuyahoga County** – 521,593 or 42.23% **State of Ohio:** 4,487,779 or 38.39%
- **Completed – Cuyahoga County** – 378,209 or 30.62% **State of Ohio:** 3,304,000 or 28.27%

Ohio's Phased Approach / Eligibility:

The following State of Ohio vaccine phases are **in effect; 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 2A, 2B, 2C and 2D** and will continue to run concurrently. Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccinations Paused in Ohio:

On April 13, 2021, Governor Mike DeWine, Ohio Department of Health Director Stephanie McCloud, and Ohio Department of Health Chief Medical Officer Bruce Vanderhoff, M.D., advised all Ohio COVID-19 vaccine providers to temporarily pause using the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine.
