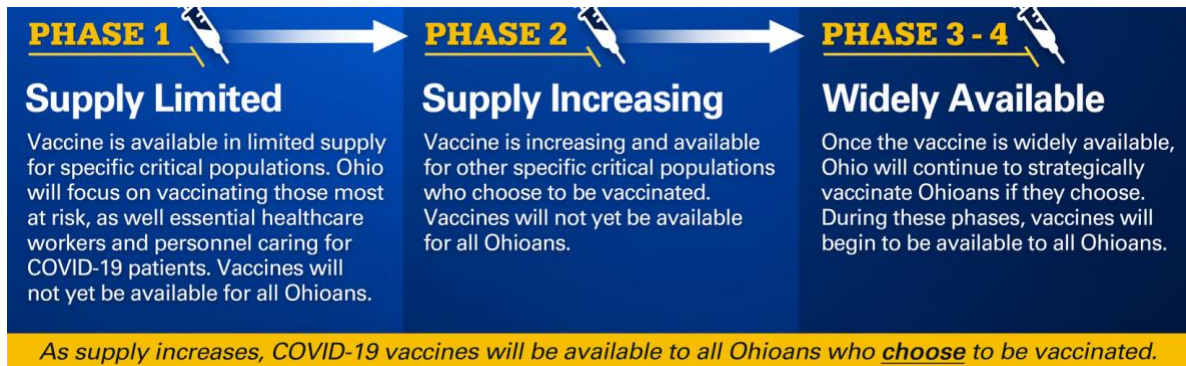

- **Started - Cuyahoga County** – 555,248 or 44.96% **State of Ohio:** 4,720,786 or 40.39%
- **Completed – Cuyahoga County** – 450,759 or 36.50% **State of Ohio:** 3,865,403 or 33.07%

Ohio's Phased Approach / Eligibility:

The following State of Ohio vaccine phases are in effect; 1B, 1C, 1D, 1E, 2A, 2B, 2C and 2D and will continue to run concurrently. How else can I register for my vaccine? The Wolstein Center Now Accepts Walk-Ins.

Location: Walk-up clinic inside the Wolstein Center at Cleveland State University, 2000 Prospect Ave. E., Cleveland, OH 44115.

Schedule: This clinic opened March 16, operating seven days a week.

- Weeks 1, 2, 3 (March 16-April 5): Pfizer vaccine – first dose.
- Weeks 4, 5, 6 (April 6-26): Pfizer – second dose for those vaccinated during weeks 1, 2, and 3.
- Weeks 7-8 (April 27-May 10): Pfizer vaccine – first dose*. Walk-ins are welcome from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

How to sign up:

- Sign up at gettheshot.coronavirus.ohio.gov. Enter ZIP code 44115 in the search field.
- Appointments also are available by phone at 1-833-4-ASK-ODH.
- Walk-ins are welcome from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- State and federal employees will be visiting certain communities to offer in-person registration.

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommended on April 23, 2021, that use of the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 vaccine could resume following a 10-day pause.
