**A RESOLUTION
ACCEPTING THE FY2021 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG)
FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY**

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant program is to protect the health and safety of the public and firefighting personnel against fire and fire-related hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for an Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, FEMA has determined that the application submitted was consistent with the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program's purpose and was worthy of award; and

WHEREAS, the FY2021 Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) funding has been approved in the amount of \$181,476.19 in Federal funding, the City is required to contribute non-Federal funds equal or greater than 5.00% of the Federal funds awarded, or \$9,073.81 for a total approved budget of \$190,550.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant will be used to purchase 5 cardiac monitor/defibrillators capable of manual shock and/or AED mode, which will replace aging and discontinued monitors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDDLEBURG HEIGHTS, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the U.S. Department of Homeland Security FY2021 Assistance to Firefighters Grant in the amount of \$181,476.19 is hereby accepted.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Middleburg Heights Code and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
