A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR A GRANT THROUGH THE 2024 CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, grant funds are now available through the Cuyahoga County Department of Housing and Community Development, and the City of Middleburg Heights desires to make application for such funding for the resurfacing of pavement on Grant Boulevard from Glenridge Avenue to the Dead End for the maintenance of health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Middleburg Heights, at a public meeting, have been given an opportunity to express their views on the aforesaid project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDDLEBURG HEIGHTS, STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council of the City of Middleburg Heights, hereby authorizes the Mayor to file an application for a Cuyahoga County Community Development Supplemental Grant in the amount of \$50,000 for the resurfacing of pavement on Grant Boulevard from Glenridge Avenue to the Dead End.

Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to enter such agreements with Cuyahoga County as may be necessary for the application for and receipt of Cuyahoga County Supplemental Grant funds and related funding, as provided by law. Said agreements shall be in substantially the form as approved by the Director of Law.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Middleburg Heights Code and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of said City, and for further reason to authorize the Mayor to file an application with the Cuyahoga County Department of Housing and Community Development for a Cuyahoga County Community Development Supplemental Grant; therefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
