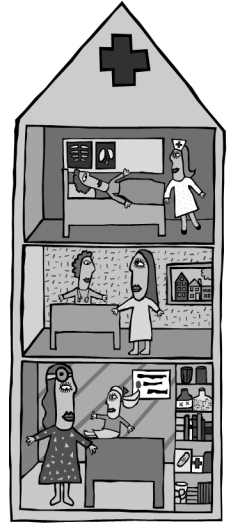

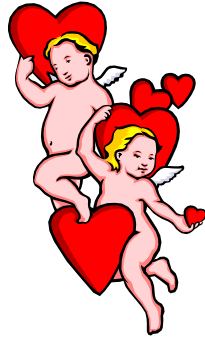

If you select the morning time, please keep in mind that Safety Town is held at that time in mid-June. The fee is \$55 for MH residents and MHCC members or \$65 for those who reside in the BCSD or attend a public/private school in the BCSD.



The Spring 2019 Soccer Season is a continuation of the Fall 2018 Season. Boys & Girls (U6-U15) who played in our Youth program in the Fall do NOT need to sign up in the Spring. They will return to the same team and will be contacted by their coach in mid-March. New players may be put on a WAITING LIST and added to a team if a spot becomes available.
